2.1	Introductions/Apologies
	TS welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2.2	Minutes of the last Meeting These were agreed.
2.3	Volunteer Awards The partnership agreed it would be good to have some volunteer awards in the village. It was agreed to have a think about what people would like to be included in the awards i.e. categories, when to hold the awards etc. and discuss at the next meeting. It was agreed that an awards ceremony with a disco and buffet would be nice. It could also be made an annual event if successful. TL said it might be good to work with the Parish Council and the Police.
2.4	Big Local Conversation Applications Tiny Explorers – As Tiny Explorers haven't attended tonight's meeting and haven't sent their apologies either, it was agreed that they will not receive any money from Big Local.
